2017-2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING

The City of Yuba City is beginning the process of determining how Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding will be allocated for the 2017-2018 Program Year. City staff will be holding a public meeting to discuss overall CDBG program objectives, solicit public input on community needs and activities for the 2017-2018 Program Year, as well as a review of the application process. **The meeting will be held:**

Notice is hereby given that the City is considering a substantial Amendment to its 2015 Consolidated Plan, 2015 Program Year and 2016 Program Year Annual Action Plan. City staff will provide an overview of the proposed amendments and solicit public input at the February 27, 2017 meeting.

The primary objective of the CDBG Program is the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanded economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income individuals/families and communities.

Eligible activities range from housing rehabilitation to public services as well as economic development and infrastructure projects. Project funding is a collaborative process that involves citizen participation as well as feedback from local service organizations and city departments.

Applications for CDBG funding will be available on the City of Yuba City website February 15, 2017. **Applications must be completed and submitted online only. Applications must be received no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 24, 2017.**
