SERVICE RATE INCREASES: AN INVESTMENT IN OUR FUTURE

Rate increases allow the City to continue to provide safe, reliable drinking water, and wastewater services to our community. These increases also prevent budget deficits, allow for critical investments in essential infrastructure, and allow the City to keep pace with cost increases and program requirements that protect our resources and public health.



CURRENT & NEW RATES

Water charges for customers vary based on water use and meter size. For example, the average residential customer with a 1" meter and a baseline allocation of 15 HCF (1 HCF = 748 gallons) per month will see a water charge increase of approximately \$1.79. A single-family residence will see a monthly wastewater rate increase of approximately \$4.24. **New rates are effective July 1, 2021. The bill received in August (for July's consumption) will reflect these rate changes.**
